This means you will still be part of our fantastic network of apprentices, and your story will still feature on our site. As well as advocating for apprenticeships as a career choice, we hope that you might also be able to support current apprentices, both in the network and further afield, when it comes to the end of an apprenticeship and the transition into their next role.

What's in it for employers and training providers?

- Input towards our communications via social media channels to support key messages and campaigns (e.g. National Apprenticeship Week).
- Get unbiased feedback from current apprentices to help us deliver you a better service.

- Have access to GetMyFirstJob recorded content for use in own promotional material.
- Apprentice Ambassadors will also naturally be advocates for their employer and training provider, spotlighting their experience and encouraging future applicants.
- Ambassadors will be exposed to experiences and areas they may not gain through their apprenticeship alone, such as networking and mentoring which will help them in their end-point assessment.
